

# High School Seniors or College Students\* Scholarship Offer

## Polk County Home and Community Education

There is one \$600 scholarship for college/university and one \$600 scholarship for technical colleges available for students presently enrolled in or entering a college, university or vocational school. Any field of study is acceptable. Men or women entering or enrolled in private colleges are eligible. A committee of HCE members will evaluate the applicants. The money will be available after the fall term is completed and a schedule of classes for second term is submitted to the HCE treasurer.

**\*NOTE:** Only applicants whose parent/grandparent/step-parent is a member of Polk County HCE are eligible.
